

## *Health Center Sponsors Alcohol Awareness Program*

**L**ehman students experienced the harsh impact of driving under the influence of alcohol when the national Save-A-Life Tour arrived on campus earlier this spring.

The high-impact informational and awareness program was sponsored by the Student Health Center.

More than 70 students used a mechanical simulator to experience how one's driving becomes impaired after as little as one drink.

The Ford Taurus seat, wheel and dashboard had five virtual monitors that simulated changes in roadways, wheel sensations, and the weather.

Bystanders could view large projection screens

showing the driver's view and a helicopter view.

To add poignance, a casket "reserved for the next drinking and driving victim" was paraded through the student cafeteria.

Participants in the program received "I'll take the keys!" bracelets to promote and identify designated drivers.
